

## GAMA SOURCE FAQs

1. What types of things are available to me on GAMA Source?

A: GAMA Source is a storehouse of leadership development resources that are made available for free to active members of GAMA International. In 2008, watch for the following resources to appear on the site:

- a. Recordings of past teleconferences
- b. Recordings of LAMP afternoon workshops
- c. Videos of LAMP general session presentations
- d. Past issues of GAMA International Journal
- e. Summaries of GAMA Foundation research projects
- f. Opportunities to rate and comment on resources
- g. Blogs, chat rooms and more

2. Is GAMA Source available to International affiliate members of GAMA?

A: GAMA Source is a benefit only for active and associate members of GAMA International. It is not available to either affiliate members or non-members of GAMA. (International affiliate members are full members of the affiliated organization in their home country and receive certain specific benefits from GAMA International as well.) GAMA will make a limited public page available so that potential members can sample the online resources available to them when they become active or associate members of GAMA International.

3. I forgot my login. Can you help me?

A: Your userid is your member number and your assigned password is your last name. Your userid can be found on your membership card and on the mailing label of your most recent issue of GAMA International Journal. If you changed your password and then forgot what you changed it to, please call member services at 888-275-0091 during regular business hours for assistance.

4. How often will resources be added to GAMA Source?

A: Very frequently throughout the year as we continue to populate the site with recordings from past programs. Watch for updates on a monthly basis.

5. Which issues of GAMA International Journal will be available online?

A: All issues from 2004 to present will be available to be searched by keyword and read online.

6. Are all of the past Field Leaders Forum teleconferences (now Best Practices teleconferences) available online?

A: Most of the past teleconferences are either available on the site or will become

available this year. Sadly, a few have been lost to time.

7. Which of the past LAMP workshops are on GAMA Source?

A: We've primarily focused on the most recent five to six years of LAMP programs, and we've only selected the most highly-rated workshops from each LAMP for inclusion on GAMA Source. Many of the workshops are already available on the site and more will be added over the coming months.

8. Which LAMP videos can be viewed on GAMA Source?

A: As with the LAMP workshops, we've selected only the most highly-rated general session presentations from the past few years for GAMA Source.

9. There are presentations that I remember from the recent past that I know were highly rated but they aren't available on GAMA Source. Why not?

A: Each year, some speakers do not grant GAMA permission to record and distribute their workshops, so those programs would never have been recorded and have now been lost to time. Also, because most professional speakers will not grant GAMA permission to record and distribute their general session presentations, very few of them will be available on GAMA Source.

10. What if I think a workshop was really great and I'm pretty sure it was recorded?

A: If there's a workshop that you found particularly compelling that isn't on the site, please let us know the speaker and the year. We'll determine whether GAMA has recording rights, and if so, we'll evaluate the program for inclusion.
